THE VA/HHHA GOAL

It is our goal to be the first choice in health care by providing safe and high quality care that meets your needs. The purpose of this program is to provide limited hours of home

care support to help Veterans who are primarily homebound. Your personal care is our first priority. It is recom-

mended that you speak with your Social Worker to explore other programs you may be eligible for. As a requirement of the program, you will be regularly evaluated approximately every 6 months from our visiting Nurses. Based on these assessments,

change in the number of authorized hours or days may occur. The Long Beach VA has partnered with agencies in the community to provide the Home Care. HHHA Staff will assign your care to one of these agencies and will be in regular contact with them to ensure
